Minutes of August 19, 2010 Meeting

These medals were issued in 1925 to commemorate the 100th anniversary of the first organized immigration of Norse people, since early colonial times, to the United States.

Gary showed certified examples of the silver thick and thin medals that he has been able to acquire.
